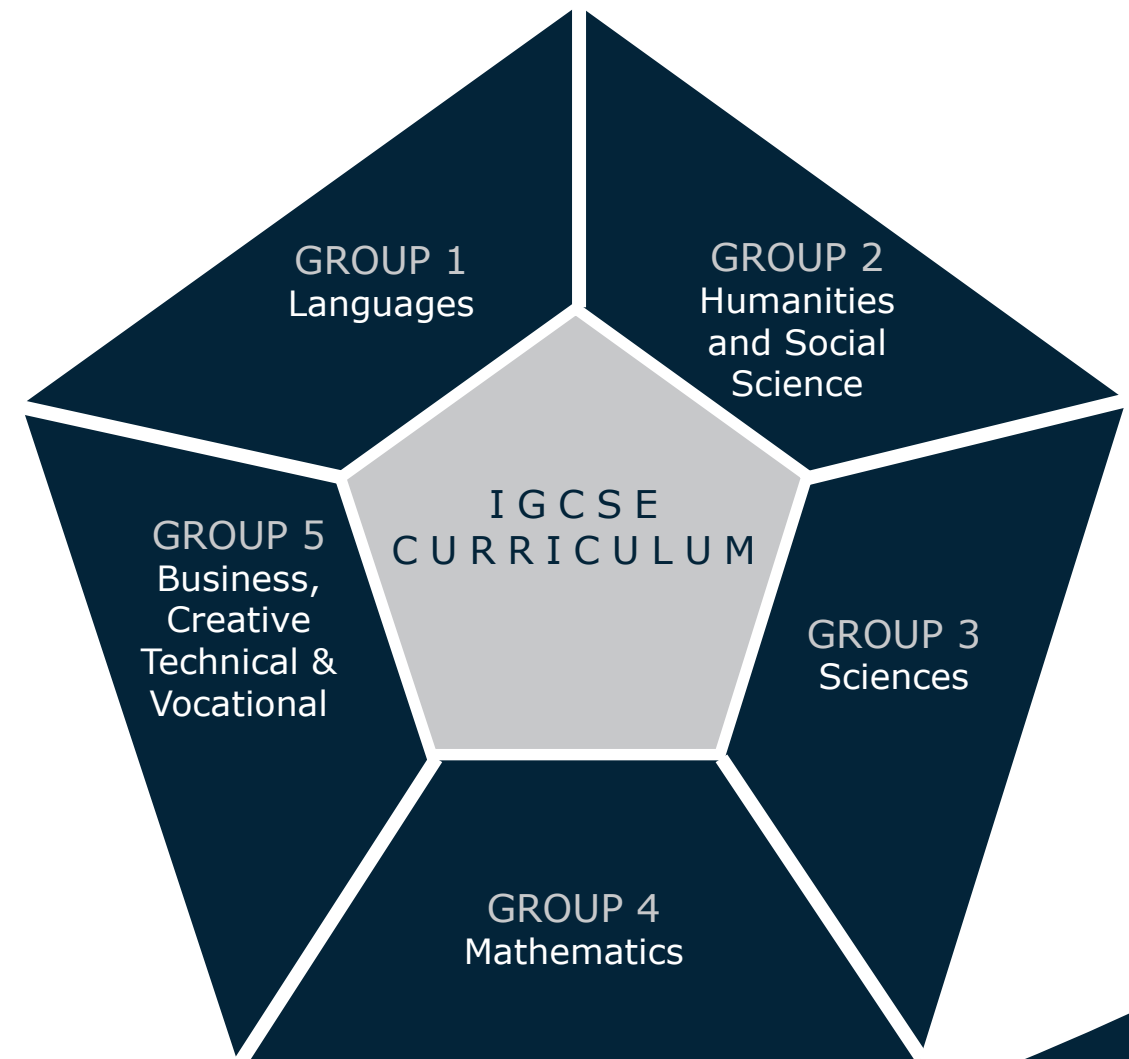

Assessments

Assessment for Cambridge IGCSE includes written and oral tests, coursework and practical assessment. Coursework is set and marked by the teacher and externally moderated by Cambridge.

Each learner's performance is benchmarked using eight internationally recognized grades. There are clear guidelines which explain the standard of achievement for different grades.

Cambridge IGCSE examination sessions occur twice a year, in May / June and October / November. Results are issued in August and January.

Engaged: intellectually and socially and ready to make a difference in the world.

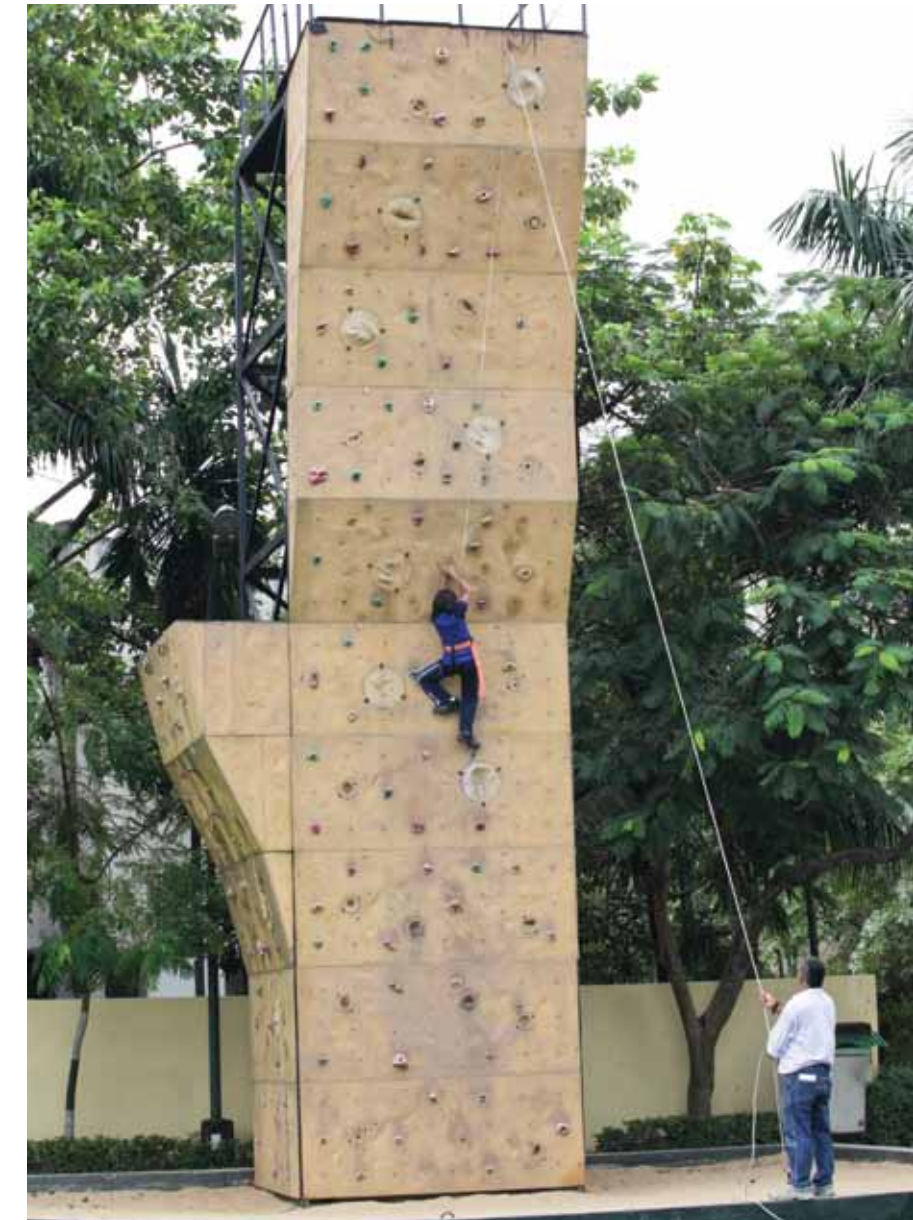
